State Examinations and Past Pupils Policy (regarding State Examinations held in the school)

Past pupils of Dominican College Muckross Park are always regarded with the greatest respect and welcomed to the school on any of the occasions that the school is open to visitors.

They are also welcome on an individual basis to meet staff and reminisce if time is available for this.

Dominican College Muckross Park does not offer a Repeat Leaving Cert programme to former students.

The Board of Management allows former students to sit their examinations in Dominican College Muckross Park if they have already completed their Leaving Certificate in the school at any prior time and are therefore returning to repeat one or more subjects at a subsequent date and in a subsequent year.

If a student has chosen to complete her education in another educational establishment, whether a conventional second level school or a fee-paying alternative, then the Board has no obligation to allow the student to return for their own convenience to sit their examinations on the premises of Dominican College Muckross Park.
